

7TH GLOBAL CAPACITY— BUILDING WORKSHOP ON GCED MENTORSHIP PROGRAMME

OVERVIEW

This report summarizes 15 GCED projects implemented by the selected mentees/grantees of APCEIU's 7th Global Capacity-Building Workshop on GCED in 2022. 15 GCED initiatives, including teacher training workshops, curriculum development, school-based activities, and community development projects, have been taken by educators, teachers, and practitioners in Asia, Europe, Africa, Latin America, and the Caribbean. The mentees/grantees first participate in the 7th Global Capacity-Building Workshop on GCED in September 2022. After the completion of the Workshop, graduates submit the GCED proposals to be selected as the grantees/mentees. The selected 15 mentees/grantees are matched with the expert mentors to be guided for their project development and implementation. This report describes the summary of 15 projects held in different corners of the world along with its outputs.

Global Citizenship Education Training for Teachers

Project Title: Global Citizenship Education Training for Teachers

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Global Citizenship Education Training for Teachers supports the mainstreaming of education for peace and inter-cultural understanding in Nigeria, the most populous black nation which is heavily divided along ethnic and religious lines. 27 in-service teachers from government primary schools within Abuja participated in the 3-day training covering environmental and climate justice, gender equity and responsiveness, socio-economic inequalities, peace and intercultural understanding as well as GCED pedagogies using socio-emotional learning.

KEY ACTIVITY 1

The SDGs card session focused on how teachers can guide students through the process of forming global citizenship knowledge, understanding, capacities and skills.



The session on Inequality in the context of Human rights class featured role play as an important pedagogy.



KEY ACTIVITY 3

The class activity tasked the teachers to think about socioeconomic inequalities among their students and identify 3 ways of reducing these inequalities in the classroom and community.


PROJECT OVERVIEW

To create an enriching exchange of nature-based knowledge between indigenous peoples and students to improve the environmental aspects of Villa Maria del Triunfo, a dirty and polluted urban area and turn it into a greener city to live.

To understand the climate migration as a social issue caused by climate change through the narration of personal experiences of indigenous peoples. Students understand the background of migration in Villa Maria del Triunfo, an urban city where discrimination, violence, crime and poverty reign and they will work together to turn it into a more dignified city to live.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project aims to create a waste management guidebook for Pesantren, undergoing five key stages. It begins with the preparation phase involving questionnaire construction, teacher interviews, and questionnaire analysis. This is followed by the processing phase encompassing reference review and content creation. Subsequently, the monitoring phase involves expert book reviews, analysis of the feedback, limited respondent trials, and analyzing trial results. The finishing stage includes book revision, editing, and layout, leading to the final step dissemination. Dissemination involves printing a limited number of books, distributing the digital copy to Pesantren, assigning an ISBN, and compiling a report.
